Some correspondence from that era are between the "Association" and Essex County Council of Jewish Agencies and allocations. Letterheads list names of board members and officers as well as Ladies Auxiliary officers and trustees.</i> <i>Later correspondence from the late 1970s to early 1980s contain typical reminders of upcoming meetings and events as well as solicitation letters and correspondence and agreements about the sale of the property on Chancellor Ave. to the Islamic Community of Masji Baytul- Khaliq. In addition there is a hand signed letter from Newark's Mayor Sharpe James to Willam Gorewitz regarding the property on Chancellor Ave.</i> <i>In August 1983 the Hebrew Sheltering Home closed its doors on Chancellor Ave. and the Jewish Counseling and Service Agency assumed the role of the provider of services to the needy and homeless.
