## **History:**

For many years Abe Haber worked with the B'nai B'rith Hillside Lodge and the Jewish community in New Jersey. He was its financial secretary for eight consecutive years from 1964-1972. He was elected to the presidency of the Lodge in 1977 and served on the Northern N.J. Council in several capacities

In addition to being a charter member of B'nai B'rith International Israel Lodge, he was appointed to the Board of Trustees of the Free Public Library of Hillside and served as its president in 1975. He was on the Board of Trustees of Temple Shomrei Torah of Hillside and was designated as the "Probian of the Year" in 1979 by the Probus Club of Hillside.

Haber was a C.P.A. and a veteran of WWII.
